Read: 2 Tim 3:16-17

We know that men wrote the Bible, but if it is inspired by God, as this scripture says, we can say that the Bible is the truth and the foundation on which we can live our lives. Agree?

So, If the word of God is the Foundation, then how should we live our lives (i.e. Make decisions, set goals, conduct business, use our money, types of relationship that we have etc) (hint: use the Word of God as a measuring stick, as meter, as a guide to live our lives)
