Ice Breaker: Are you an introvert or an extravert? Explain why and would the group agree?

- 1. What was one thing that spoke to you the most, from this week's message?
- 2. Read Ephesian 6:12 what influences us most when we are wrestling with something. Where does our wrestle come from.
- 3. Have you considered there is another way to pray to God other than in English? Read 1 Corinthians 14:14
- 4. If our struggles are in the Spiritual realm and our victories are won in the spiritual, how does a prayer language or speaking in tongues benefit the follower of Jesus. (Hint: Answers are found in Romans 8:26, 1 Corinthians 14:4).
- 5. What can be some of the obstacles in speaking in tongues as a prayer language.
- 6. If there are people who desire to receive the gift of tongues, lay hands on them and pray for them. Encourage them to speak out the language and not just receive prayer.

Note: If you, as a leader, do not have this gift, please be transparent about your own experience. Having the gift of tongues is not the only evidence of being filled with the Spirit. The Fruits of the spirit are the evidence of the infilling of the Holy Spirit. Many Christians around the world speak in tongues and consider praying in another language to God as a common Christian experience.
