Get the Conversation Started:

Share a testimony from Sunday that really impacted you and why?

Series in Review

Read the below "review" statements one at a time and have a few people share how they have grown through this series. Ask: What changed in your life? What have you seen God do in your life or those around you? Have you experienced Jesus in a new way?

Knowing your Pioneers call, starts with an encounter with a pioneering God. Moses encounters God in the burning bush - who gives him instructions to free Israel from the slavery of Egypt.

A pioneers call will require a call to action - Moses had to decide if he was going to follow through on what God asked of him.

Every Pioneer will face resistance that will require persistence. We should view our obstacles, as stepping stones, not roadblocks. It's in the obstacles that gives God an opportunity to provide a miracle.

What are we taking on this journey? Hebrews 12:1-3 tells us to throw off everything that hinders. We talked about what are you carrying in your mind, your wallets and your heart. Think on the right things (get rid of critical negative talk), be generous, and don't carry bitterness or anger, but forgiveness and love.

We need to know why we are on the path if we are going to stay on the path. The Purpose of the Path is found in the person of Jesus. He has called you to be intermediaries /agents/ ambassadors representing God to this world. God wanted to overcome the oppression of the Egyptians and wanted to bring Israel to their promised land, where He could be their King. And He wants to do the same for all people.

Taking the promises of God requires a tailored word from God. Joshua received the instructions needed to overcome the fortified city Jericho. We took off our shoes to acknowledge the presence of God and to ask for a strategy to overcome those things that are in the way of our promises.

Pray:

Pray that we would faithfully walk in obedience to Jesus and his word. That we would continue to be pioneers following the ultimate pioneer who is Jesus. Pray that we should show the world who Jesus is and represent him well, by the way we live our lives.
